The hybrid session, conducted both offline and online, saw participation from around 800 students apart from the faculty members. Interns Himanshu, Estuti Mishra, Madhav Krishna Trekha, Shruti, and Taruna led discussions on various cybercrimes, preventive measures, and the significance of digital wellbeing and awareness among teenagers.

Valedictorian Ceremony of Cyber Swachhta Mission 3.0 - The valedictorian ceremony of Chandigarh Police's Cyber Swachhta Mission 3.0 internship program took place on August 04, 2024 at New Secretariat, Sector 9, Chandigarh in which Ms. Lavya, Ms. Estuti and Mr. Himanshu, cyber interns from the Digital Safety Club got selected among the top five interns out of over 350 participants. The interns were felicitated by the Home Minister, Shri Amit Shah, the Governor of Chandigarh, Shri Gulab Chand Kataria, and the Union Home Secretary, Shri Ajay Kumar Bhalla.

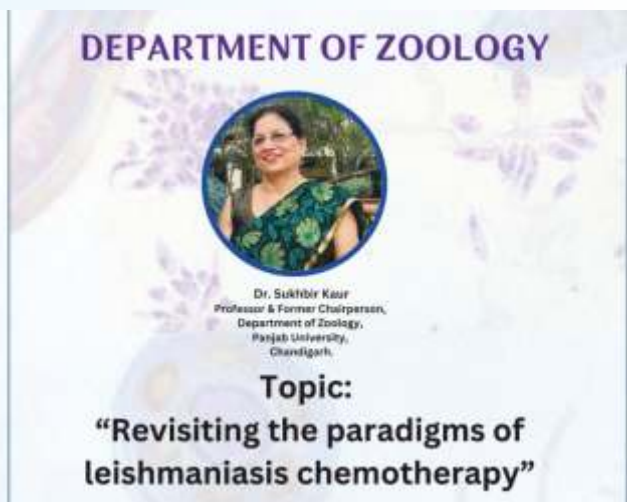

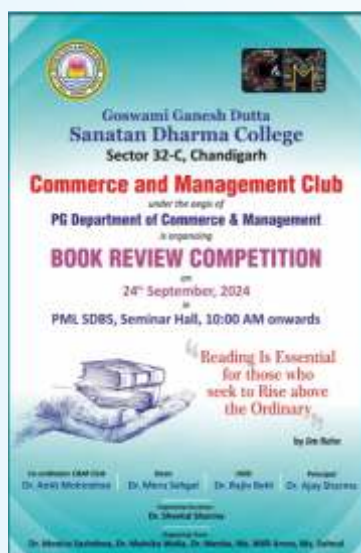
