Dr Kumar has been UGC- Emeritus Fellow, ICSSR Senior Fellow and Director, V.K. Krishna Menon Centre for International Relations of the University of Kerala. He was also the Director General of the Institute of Parliamentary Affairs, Government of Kerala.

An internationally renowned scholar in Political Science, he specializes in Comparative Politics, International Relations and Kerala Politics. He is a noted psephologist and was the state Coordinator for the CSDS surveys in Kerala during 1996-2006.

He has won several international and national fellowships including UGC Research Scientist; Fulbright Award; Indo-French Cultural Exchange Award; International Visitors Leadership Award; Salzburg Award; Shastri Indo-Canadian Award, University of Calgary, Alberta and MC Gill University, Montreal, Canada; Fulbright International Educational Cooperation Award; Visiting Professor, University of Calgary; Visiting Professor, Claremont Graduate University, Australia; India Council Senior Fellowship, Monash University, Melbourne and Visiting Research Fellow, University of New South Wales, Sydney.

Dr Kumar has been part of many prestigious projects. He was Co-Director, Fulbright International Educational Co-operation Program, a collaborative partnership project on "Bridging the Gaps in Political Science: Methodology and Values," jointly organised by the University of Kerala, India and Claremont Graduate University, California, USA (2002-2006); Director, ICSSR Project on "Problems of Rehabilitation of Gulf Returnees and Issues in Policy Making" (2004-2005); Coordinator for Kerala UPIASI Project on "Dimensions of Coalition Politics in Kerala" (2004-2006); Coordinator, UGC - Special Assistance Program (DRS-I), Department of Political Science, University of Kerala (2007-2011); Director, UGC Nehru Studies Centre, University of Kerala (2005-2011). He also has membership of many professional bodies.

# Awarded 'A+' Grade by NAAC

Our College has been awarded A+ Grade by the National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC) in the 3rd cycle of institutional assessment by the NAAC peer team. The three-member NAAC team had visited the college campus on January 30 and 31 and had assessed it under the new grading system.

The high level NAAC Peer Team comprised of the following members:

Sharing the reasons behind the high grade clinched by the College, Principal Dr. Bhushan Kumar Sharma said that the new grade was due to the consistent efforts put in recent years to upgrade in all fields.

Dr Bhushan said, "This time, the college has seen an elevation of 37 points in the score given by the NAAC team, taking us from Grade 'A' to 'A+'. In the last four years, the college has gone in for complete automation and is a paper-free campus. The NAAC team observed that the college has the finest ICT-enabled infrastructure for teaching and learning in the region and that it boasts of high demand ratio for all courses."

## NEW INFRASTRUCTURE

Our college boasts of a sprawling campus with lush green lawns, an ultra-modern auditorium and multiple teaching blocks. The administrative offices of the college have been shifted to the newly constructed Administrative Block. The block consists of the office of the Principal, the office of the Managing Society and a Seminar Hall with a seating capacity of 210 people. The entire administrative block is centrally air-conditioned and has Wi-Fi facility.



An underground reservoir with a storage capacity of 3 lakh litres of water has been constructed to supply water to the hostels and college uninterruptedly. 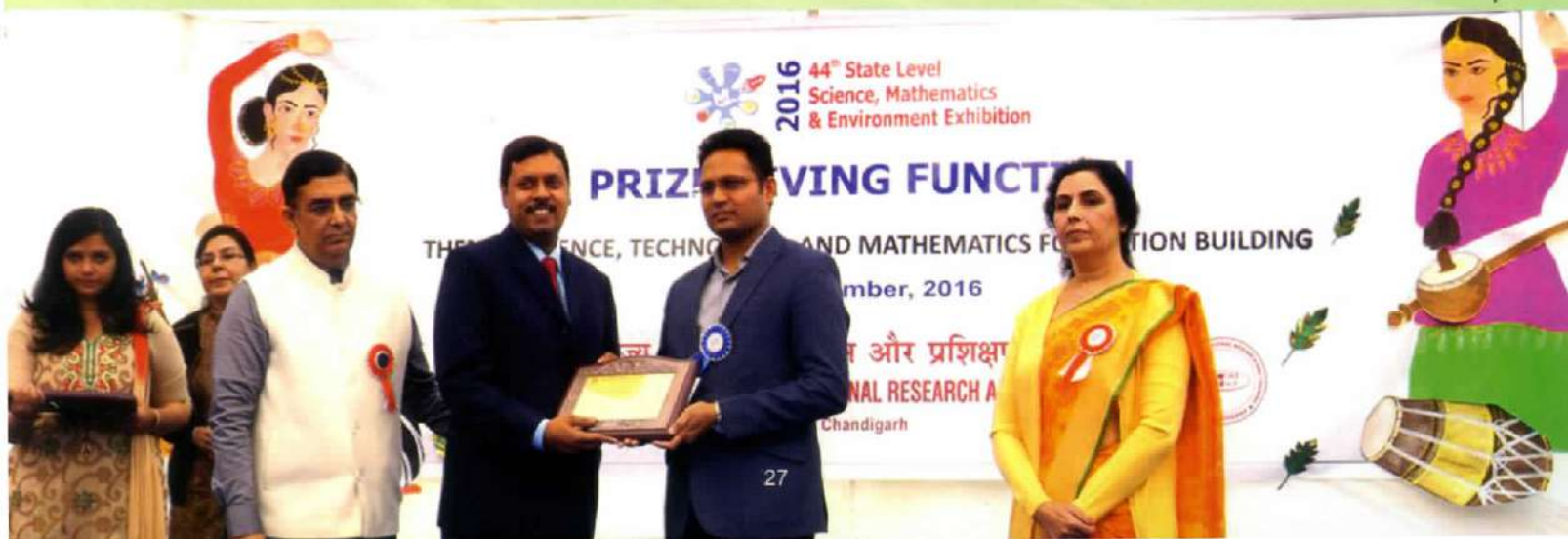

- New books and resources are added every year. The online resources subscribed to by the Library are accessible to staff and students (using passwords) from anytime, anywhere. Students can give feedback through Online Feedback Form.
- Digital library has 15 i5 computers for students and 10 i7 computers for staff. The library is automated with integrated ERP software named TCSION. JAWS: screen reading software for facilitating visually impaired students has also been installed.

### Quiz Competitions

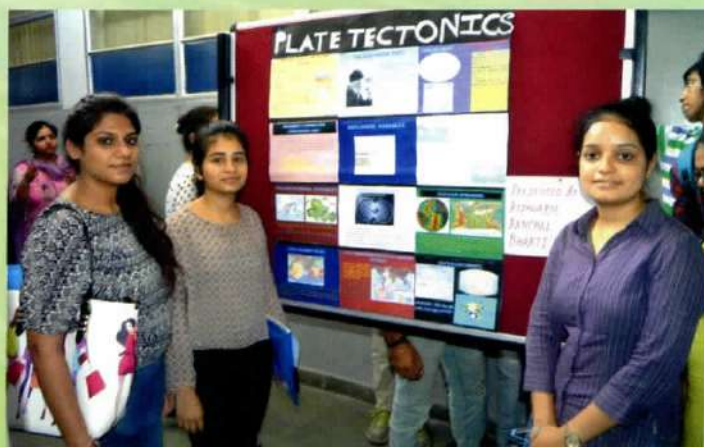

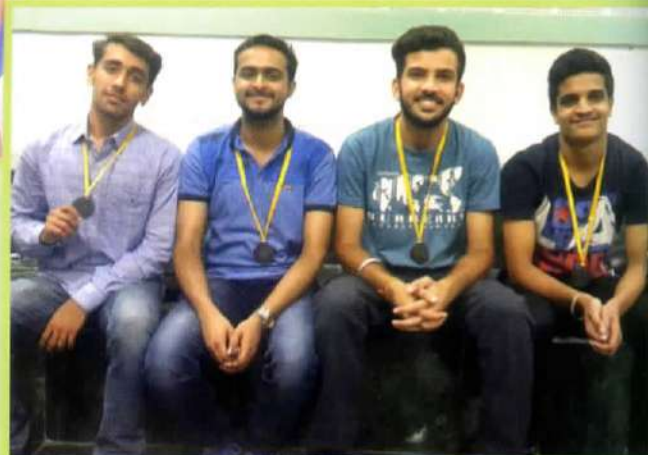
