Innovation is the key to academic excellence and nobody understands it better than Professor (Dr) Jaspal Singh Sandhu, Vice-Chancellor of Guru Nanak Dev University, Amritsar. Widely known in academic circles for his progressive ideas, Prof Sandhu is credited with initiating many innovative and inter-disciplinary programs in the University.

Owing to his initiative, GNDU established the Department of Sports Medicine and Physiotherapy in 1995, the first Department of Sports Medicine in any university in India. It was later recognized under "Centre with Potential for Excellence in Particular Area" program of the University Grants Commission (UGC).

An Orthopedic Surgeon by training, Prof Sandhu's special interest areas include research and education in Sports Medicine. Under his guidance, the University started many innovative programs like PhD in Sports Medicine and Sports Physiotherapy, Masters in Sports Physical Therapy, Masters in Exercise Physiology and Nutrition, Masters in Sports Psychology etc.

Before taking over as the vice chancellor of GNDU, Prof Sandhu was Secretary, UGC and had earlier held many academic and administrative positions in GNDU.


Prof Sandhu is also a member of the Editorial and Advisory Boards of a number of international institutions. He is Fellow of National Academy of Medical Sciences (India), Fellow of the International Federation of Sports Medicine, Fellow of Asian Federation of Sports Medicine and many more. He was the first Indian to become the Secretary General of Asian Federation of Sports Medicine and allied areas. He has over 235 research publications in journals of international repute.

The Management, Principal, students and staff of the College are honoured to have a man of the stature of Prof Sandhu in their midst.

PRINCIPAL NEWS

Under the able guidance and leadership of Principal Dr Bhushan Kumar Sharma, the college was awarded A+ Grade by the National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC) in the 3rd cycle of institutional assessment by the NAAC peer team. Every year the college awards many scholarships after careful evaluation of the deserving students. LIBRARY

The College library is enriched with a carefully built collection of books written by reputed authors. At present the physical collection of the library includes 69,267 books, 3,476 CD/D 108 journals & magazines and 22 newspapers. Digital collection of the library includes 31, 35,000 e-books 6,000+ e-journals (through INFLIBNET N-List programme). New resources are added to the collection every year ensure staff and students have access to the latest quality resources for teaching, research and study. The on resources subscribed to by the library are accessible to staff and students (using passwords) from anytic anywhere. Students can give feedback regarding library services and resources through Online Feedback Fo available on the college website.



Digital library has 15 i5 computers for students and 10 i7 computers for staff. The library is automated with integrated ERP software named TCSION. JAWS: screen reading software for facilitating visually impaired students has also been installed on two computers in the Digital Library. 



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
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Independence Day and Republic Day

Dr Ajay Sharma, Dean, Cultural Affairs of the College proposed the vote of thanks.




INTERNATIONAL EVENTS


Traditional Dance form of Africa

The event was jointly organised by Departments of English and Political Science of the College.




LEGAL AWARENESS CELL


