AUTOMATION THROUGH TCSION

- Digital campus: It is commonly known as Campus Management Systems (CMS). It organises students' information from admissions to the declaration of results. It includes student enrolment, hostel occupancy, fee payment, batch allocation, attendance, application for leave, and viewing results (MST and Final exam results). The students are given login IDs to view their profiles. Faculty Management (HRMS) is also part of the system to mark students' attendance, apply for their leave and entering marks.
- Digital learning: Learning Exchange module (LX) system helps teachers and students to upload and share various contents. This facility proved very useful for students and faculty during the lockdown period. There are two other modules called Finance and Accounting, and Procurement and Inventory which help to reduce the load of administrative staff.
- Google Classroom: All classes were held through online mode by using Google Classroom/ Meet as per the time table during the lockdown period. Teachers were given training for using the Google Meet platform for teaching in online mode. Later on, exams were also conducted through this mode.
- ICT: ICT took various initiatives for faculty and students. All the faculty were encouraged to get registered on the various portals like National Digital Library Swayam Prabha and Swayam portal. ICT academy in association with Tech Mahindra (business process services) organised a virtual placement drive.

LIBRARY

Goswami Ganesh Dutta Sanatan Dharam College Library is a state-of-the-art academic library in the region. At present, the physical collection of the library includes 70,749 books, 3,520 CD/DVDs, 92 journals and magazines, and 23 newspapers. A college component of the e-Shodh Sindhu consortium has access to 6,000+ journals, 1,64,300+ e-books under N-LIST, and 6,00,000 e-books through NDL (National Digital Library of India).

New resources are added to the collection every year to ensure staff and students have access to the latest quality resources for teaching, research, and study. College Library provides an anti-plagiarism software called URKUND. Information Services like OPAC (Online Public Access Catalogue), Reprographic Service, ILL (Inter-Library Loan), Internet Surfing, Current Content Alert, SMS Alert Services, Previous Year Question Papers Alert, Employment News, and New Arrival Books are provided to the users of the library. The library staff conducts user orientation programmes to familiarise the users with library collection and resources.

IQAC

IQAC interaction with faculty on Revised Accreditation Framework (RAF): In-depth deliberations and discussions on RAF (Revised Accreditation Framework) and National Education Policy- 2020 was held by the IQAC of the institute on 16 September 2020; 183 faculty members interacted through the online platform. 
Quiz Contest




Contribution to PM CARES FUND by Staff

Creation of COVID-19 Counselling Cell



Effective use of Social media and College Website during COVID-19

This included sharing a video on the use of reusable face cover and sharing of a document, released by Ayush, on measures to boost immunity.

DrTarundeep Kaur of the Department of Psychology was a member of a team constituted by the


IndianAcademy of Health Psychology (IAHP) for combating the psychological problems arising due to the pandemic. She performed the duty of a Psychology Consultant.


Online Prarthana Sabha




Basant Panchmi


NCC



The College has been granted 2 NCC platoons comprising 70 cadets each. During each session, NCC cadets attend 32 parades and 96 periods for the award of the certificate. To specialize or train himself for a career in the armed forces, it becomes mandatory for cadets to attend two camps during the three years of their stay in the college and participate in certain service achievements, as decided by the authorities. Cadets are also groomed for a regular commission in the army and paramilitary forces. 
NSS
