LOHRI CELEBRATION









Dr. Harvinder Kaur Chahal, HOD Punjabi Department apprised the students about women consciousness, women rights and empowerment.











The members of the Rotaract Club hosted an event called 'Benevolence' and celebrated Valentines with children of slum areas of Ramdarbar on 14 February.




'Asthétique', an event was organized by the Rotaract Club from 10-12 February. The hype of aesthetic photography in the world right now gave the idea of heading this event.





















The Examination Team of the college smoothly conducted the Panjab University online examinations for odd semester which commenced from 24 January.


