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










Mock fire drills were conducted for entire class D staff to assure preparedness for emergency situation and to augment their response timing.



Yoga Session for Staff & Students








A lecture on the theme 'The place of Yoga in the Indian Tradition' was organised by the Department of Hindi in collaboration with the Department of Sanskrit.

COLLEGE RANKINGS




