


National Investor Awareness Program

The certification speaks volumes of the dedication and commitment of the college to not only make the institution exemplary but also inspire the students to work to their optimal capacity.




Alumni Meet 2022

Health and Wellness





SEVEN DAY NSS CAMP


DAY 1


DAY 3


The grand win at the Panjab University Youth and Heritage Festival 2022 was celebrated at the college on 7 November.
